He reminded all to be aware of people surrounding banks who watch for customers with deposits/withdrawals. Then follow, robb of cash: "bank jugging". Also those persons ringing doorbells, no answer, stealing packages (porch pirates).

Next came the reading of the minutes and approval with second.

Anna Neff presented The Financial Report and providing copies of the Profit and Loss Statement. The HOA Board voted to drop drive by inspections for code violations. Changes were made by management to not charge separately for record keeping, postage, fees.

For the townhome members, the contract for lawn services and sprinkler maintenance was renewed. Peggy Bloomer will continue as HOA contact with contractor for any problems.

Members backing to wooded park were reminded NOT to put food stuff out to attract varmints.
